Events

The SSC **events team** organizes sustainability-related events that are mainly targeted at students of ETH Zurich, but open to everyone. We already hosted a large variety of events – from large event series around big environmental challenges to small excursions about local nature.


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The first highlight of the spring semester was, as usual, the **Sustainability Week** (*Nachhaltigkeitswoche Zürich NHWZ*). During the third week of the spring semester, students from the five universities of Zurich (ETH, UZH, ZHdK, ZHAW and PHZH) presented over 40 events. Of course, the SSC events team worked hard to contribute to this large event.

Throughout the year, **many smaller events** have been organized, such as the informal lunch on eco-feminism. We organized talks on "1.5°C and Degrowth", "Healthy Vegan Diet", "Sustainable Careers" or "Ecosystems and Biodiversity". More interactive events were a tofu workshop where participants could produce tofu themselves and a roundtable on "Decolonizing Ecology and the Environmental Sciences".

In the autumn semester, the big highlight was the events series **Mirror COP27**, held during the climate summit COP27 in Egypt. For this event series, we collaborated with several organizations around ETH. The Mirror COP27 was an intense couple of weeks, to say the least: there was such a nice diversity of events, so many people mobilised for it, and a lot of interesting discussions. We're aiming to turn it into a yearly thing, so see you at Mirror COP28!





Development

The SSC **development team** focuses on making ETH more sustainable at the institutional level, through working groups with specific focuses such as mobility, education, and food. It closely works together with the VSETH HoPo team (university politics team) and other units at ETH, such as ETH Sustainability and Campus Services. Members of the development team hold several delegate positions of VSETH, which makes them the elected representative of students for their project.



Over the course of the spring semester, the SSC Development Team also initiated the creation of **working groups** on the topics of **education, campus mobility, divestment, net zero, energy & infrastructure, and biodiversity on campus**. These working groups were a consequence of the dialogue between SSC and ETH Sustainability about the ETH Sustainability Report 2019/2020. In the working groups, which are still active, students come together to develop proposals to incorporate sustainability in these different domains of ETH. These proposals are then brought forward to the responsible people in the ETH administration in coordination with VSETH.

The development team was also involved in the **Food4Thought** event in the beginning of April, a 3-day fare on the topic of sustainable food organized by ETH Sustainability. Here, the SSC was running a stand where visitors could make their own bee wax cloths for food conservation using locally produced beeswax and cotton cloth retrieved from thrown-away clothing, while also promoting the activities of the committee.

In May, the **food team** gave a presentation during a session of the gastronomy commission, where they presented the results of a survey among students from December 2021 on the topic of vegetarian and vegan food choices at the ETH



cafeterias. This survey showed that there was demand for more vegetarian and vegan food choices. The president of VSETH in demanding then joined the delegate to the gastronomy committee that the vegan choice at the larger ETH cafeterias should be among the cheapest, at a price of 6.50 CHF.





Outreach

The **outreach team** is dedicated to building connections and partnerships with other organizations that are focused on sustainability, both within and outside of ETH. It was founded in 2022 and successfully organized a first sustainability summit at ETH.



In May, the SSC outreach team organized the first **ETH Sustainable Initiatives Summit**. This summit proved a success in bringing together a diverse range of initiatives by ETH students, staff and alumni. It promoted different aspects of sustainability in academic and everyday life. 18 different sustainability initiatives presented themselves in short pitches of five minutes and were able to network at the following apéro. On this note, the team created a Slack workspace for an improved network between the initiatives.

In the autumn semester, the team participated in the second version of the Sustainability Summit which was hosted by ETH Sustainability this time. It included posters

from the different initiatives showcasing their work and a networking event.

The outreach team is in contact with sustainability organizations from outside ETH as well, such as the university associations of the other universities in Zurich or of EPFL. It also joined the newly established "Green Teams" network, which connects sustainability-oriented teams in companies across Zürich.

Communication

The **communications team** is responsible for promoting the organization and ensuring a strong online presence to be a resource for ETH students on sustainability issues.

The communication team promotes our projects and events on **social media**. The team is active on Instagram, Facebook and Twitter. They post sustainability related posts, e.g., for special days in the year dedicated to sustainability like the Biodiversity Day (May 22), the Sustainable Gastronomy Day (June 18), or Overshoot Days (May 13 for Switzerland)





One yearly highlight of the communication team is the **advent calendar** on Instagram, where there is one post everyday with interesting sustainability knowledge, facts about SSC, giveaways and more.
